

SRF Notice to Property Owners - 09/10/20

NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS

Construction improvements to the Town Sewer System including Sewer Pipes, Sewer Manholes and Sewer Pump Stations are currently ongoing and are being financed by the Massachusetts Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF). The CWSRF program is administered by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MDEP) with joint funding from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the State of Massachusetts. This project consists of installation of a new lining system in the existing sewer pipes, manholes & service connections in the Bristow Street area (*Project # CWSRF-4514, Sewer Rehab Subsystem 1C*) as well as upgrades to the Lincoln Ave Pump Station (*Project # CWSRF-4492, Lincoln Ave PS Upgrades – Phase II*), and will provide necessary upgrades/improvements that are intended to minimize the risk of SSO events, reduce infiltration and associated treatment costs. CWSRF programs operate around the country to provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects our valuable water resources nationwide.
