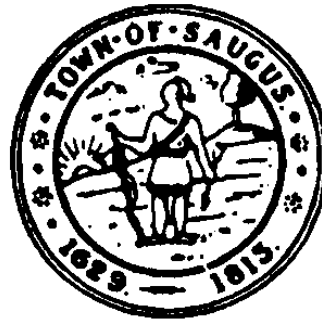

Recycling/Trash Information

General Trash Information

The Town of Saugus is contracted with JRM Hauling and Recycling to pick-up the following:

Five (5) items per one-family building

Seven (7) items per two-family building

Ten (10) items per three family building

Residential customers shall place regular weekly refuse in durable water-tight containers or plastic bags of sufficient strength to prevent failing.

Each container or bag shall not exceed thirty-five (35) gallon capacity or fifty (50) pounds in weight.

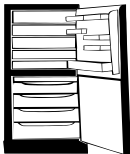
Trash/recyclables must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. the morning of collection.

Each unit is entitled to one (1) Bulky Waste Item, bag or barrel with the proper \$2 (two) Green Sticker affixed and visible.

Sticker Program

Each unit is entitled to one White Good Item with the proper \$20 (twenty) red sticker affixed, visible and called into JRM at 1-800-323-4285 the evening before your pick-up.

Stickers may be purchased at Town Hall, Saugus Federal Credit Union, Shaw's and Stop & Shop courtesy booths.



Remove doors and affix sticker

Red Sticker Items - \$20 - Collected with a different truck.

Used for the disposal of white goods/appliances such as refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers, air conditioners, water heaters, dishwashers, heavy metal files, heavy metal cabinets or desks.

Green Sticker Items - \$2 - Used for any item

that can go into the trash truck

Used for Bulk Items such as furniture, mattress/box spring, microwave ovens, rugs/carpeting (1 room same color carpet cut to 4' lengths), lawn mowers (gas tank and oil removed), small bundle of wood (cut to 4' lengths).

Used for 1 bag or barrel of items not thrown out in weekly such as small toys, worn clothing, decorations, household items, scrap wood or craft supplies, etc.



Used for one extra bag of weekly trash

Weekly Recycling Information

In Compliance with State Regulations the Town of Saugus no longer picks up any visible recycling materials with weekly trash collection. Recycling materials that have been banned from the waste stream include: cardboard, paper, cans, plastic and glass bottles. The Town of Saugus encourages (and will be enforcing) you dispose of your recyclables properly. Please prepare you recyclables as follows:

PAPER/CARDBOARD

Items placed in paper bag or bin

Newspapers/inserts, magazines, catalogs, phone books, junk mail, office paper, brown paper bags.

Corrugated cardboard (flattened or broken down to 2'X2' tied in bundles or placed in paper bags.



Paperboard (cereal, cracker boxes). Remove plastic liners

NO plastic bags

CONTAINERS

Glass bottles/jars, all colors and sizes

Aluminum/tin/steel cans and lids

Plastic containers  to 

Milk cartons and juice boxes

NO Aluminum, plastic bags

NO cans or bottles containing paint, aerosol or hazardous materials

NO window glass, dishes, Pyrex, ceramics



CURBSIDE LEAF DISPOSAL

Curbside leaf collections will take place once in the spring and three times in the fall, dates to be announced. Curbside leaf collections are on your regular collection day. There will be no "missed pickups" conducted. The Town asks that you please do your part in proper preparation for disposal. We ask that you abide by the following rules:

Leaves must be out for collection **by 7:00 a.m.** on your regular rubbish collection day.

Leaf containers must be physically separated from trash and recycling.



Paper leaf bags are preferred for leaf disposal. If barrels are used to contain the leaves, they must be clearly marked **YARD WASTE** and remove covers so the leaves are visible. No plastic bags or cardboard boxes will be accepted. No branches or brush will be collected.

Please note that separate trucks collect the rubbish, recycling and leaves; so the leaves may be collected at a different time of day.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DAY(s) We hold two events each year in the months of May and October. You must pre-register by calling 231-4115, Tires, Propane Tanks, TV's and Computers will also be collected for an additional fee. Stickers for this event are sold at lower level of Town Hall only approximately 1 month prior to event.
