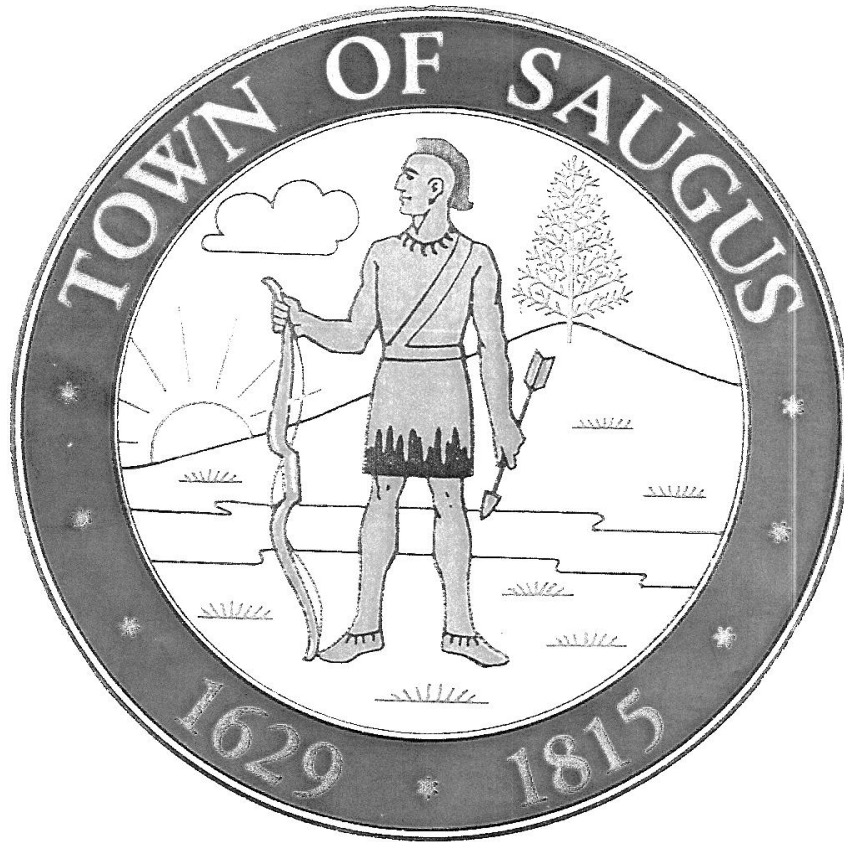

FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum of money, not to exceed \$250,000 for the purpose of conducting a feasibility study for the possible repair/renovation or construction of the science labs at Saugus High School under the MSBA Science Lab Initiative, including the payments of costs incidental or related thereto; to determine whether this appropriation shall be raised by borrowing or otherwise; or to take any other action relative thereto. (School Committee)

Recommendation: Voted to appropriate a sum of money, not to exceed \$250,000 for the purpose of conducting a feasibility study for the possible repair/renovation or construction of the science labs at Saugus High School under the MSBA Science Lab Initiative, including the payments of costs incidental or related thereto; this appropriation shall be raised by borrowing.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds (FY2013 Chapter 90 Highway) a sum of money for street resurfacing. Said sum will be reimbursed by the Commonwealth under the provisions of MGL chapter 90, section 34. (Town Manager)

Recommendation: Voted to raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds (FY2013 Chapter 90 Highway) a sum of \$505,685.80 for street resurfacing. Said sum will be reimbursed by the Commonwealth under the provisions of MGL chapter 90, section 34.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds (18% of FY2013 Chapter 90 Highway Funds) for handicapped ramps and sidewalks. Said sum will be reimbursed by the Commonwealth under the provisions of MGL Chapter 90, section 34. (Town Manager)

Recommendation: Voted to raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds \$111,004.20 (18% of FY2013 Chapter 90 Highway Funds) for handicapped ramps and sidewalks. Said sum will be reimbursed by the Commonwealth under the provisions of MGL Chapter 90, section 34.
