Task Requirements must be completed with in 18 months of initial application approval. Apprentice must be under direct supervision of a licensed practitioner when performing tasks. Client must be advised that the person performing a body art activity is an apprentice. The apprentice must obtain written consent from the client and affixed to the application and consent form for body art activity.

Copy of client consent form must be on file for Board of Health review. Form must dictate apprentice task being performed.

Refer to Town of Saugus Board of Health Article 23 (Regulation of Body art) for Prohibited/Restricted Body Piercings and activities.

Upon completion of the task requirements within 18 months, a review test will may be administered and a passing grade of C or better must be attained.
