- NEVER SMOKE while handling hazardous material

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION DAY

Saugus, MA – Residents will be able to dispose of their household hazardous waste at an upcoming collection sponsored by the Board of Health.

The household hazardous waste collection event will be held **Saturday, October 1, 2016** from 9:00am – 12:00pm rain or shine. The collection allows residents to dispose of household hazardous materials in an environmentally responsible manner.

Only Saugus residents who pre-register will be allowed to dispose of their waste at the collection event. Details will be provided at the time of pre-registration starting Monday, September 5, 2016 at the Inspectional Services Department of the Town Hall. Proof of residency is required and no commercial waste will be accepted. A pre-registered type of event reduces wait time and ensures that all registered participants are serviced. Residents may pre-register by calling Inspectional Services at (781) 231-4115.

The following is a summary of what items residents can dispose of at the event: oil based paints, varnishes, stains, turpentine, paint thinners, solvents, adhesives, photography chemicals, insecticides, pesticides, herbicides, fungicides, cesspool cleaners, oven cleaners, drain cleaners, transmission fluids, degreasers, antifreeze, brake fluids and car batteries. TV's and Monitors are currently free of charge; propane tanks will require a \$5.00 sticker; automobile tires are \$3.00 a piece and truck tires \$10.00 a piece. Stickers may be purchased at the Saugus Inspectional Services Department; all of the stickers must be purchased prior to the event. Do not bring explosives, ammunition or latex paint (latex paint may be dried out and disposed of in the regular trash).

Residents will be limited to two (2) car loads which is 50 lbs or 50 gallons of hazardous waste.

DIRECTIONS TO OPEN 2016 HHW COLLECTION EVENTS

Amesbury: *From Route 95 North:* take exit 58B. Turn onto Route 110 (Macy Street) going west toward Amesbury. At fourth traffic light, take left onto Rte. 150, go under the Rt. 495 overpass and take first right on to South Hunt Road. Go down South Hunt Road (past the Amesbury Sports Park on your left) for 1.5 miles and the Amesbury Compost Site is on your left.

From Route 495 South: take exit 54. At the end of the ramp take a right and then an immediate right on to South Hunt Road. Go down South Hunt Road (past the Amesbury Sports Park on your left) for 1.5 miles and the Amesbury Compost Site is on your left. Some GPS or navigation systems have South Hunt Road listed as Hunt Road.

Boxford / Middleton / Topsfield: Masconomet High School, Endicott Road, Topsfield

From Route 95, take Exit 51, Endicott Rd, Topsfield. (From 95 N turn right onto Endicott Rd; from 95 S, turn left). Take the 1st driveway to the right on Endicott Road into Masconomet High School.

Lynn: DPW, 250 Commercial Street, Lynn

From Route 1 Saugus – Southbound or Northbound: take Walnut Street exit towards Lynn. Turn right on Kirtland Street. Take 1st left onto Marion Street. Turn slight right onto Federal Street. Turn slight left onto Market Square. Stay straight to go onto S. Common Street. Take 1st right onto Commercial Street. After crossing over the Lynnway (Route 1A), Lynn DPW will be on your left.

Newburyport: Recycling Center, 1 Crow Lane (Spring event)

From Rte 95, take exit 57 / Rte 113 east towards Newburyport.

Coming from the North: take left at light onto Rte 113 east. At 2ND set of lights, take right onto Low Street.

Coming from the South, take right onto Rte 113 east. At first set of lights, take right onto Low Street.

Go 0.7 mile on Low Street. Take right onto Crow Lane. Recycling Center will be first gated driveway on the left once past the farm and fields.

Newburyport: DPW Yard, 16 A Perry Way (Fall event)

From Rte 95, take exit 57 / Rte 113 east towards Newburyport.

Coming from the North: take left at light onto Rte 113 east. At 2ND set of lights -gas station on right- take right onto Low Street.

Coming from the South, take right onto Rte 113 east. At first set of lights – gas station on right- take right onto Low Street.

Go 1.5 miles on Low Street. Take right onto Perry Way. DPW will be down on your right.

What Hazardous Products Can I Bring?

General Household Materials

- Acids (corrosives)
- Aerosol cans (excluding empty cans)
- Art supplies
- Batteries - Alkaline batteries manufactured before 1994 and all NiCad, button, zinc and lithium batteries
- Chemistry set chemicals
- Fiberglass resins
- Furniture, floor, metal polishes and strippers
- Hobby supplies (rubber cement, airplane glue etc.)
- Mercury containing devices (switches, thermostats, fluorescent lamps, compact fluorescent bulbs (energy efficient bulbs), broken fluorescent bulbs, thermometers, blood pressure equipment)
- Moth balls/crystals
- Oil paint and paint thinners, varnish, stain and shellac (no Latex Paint is allowed)
- Paint Strippers
- Photography chemicals
- Rug and upholstery cleaners
- Solvent adhesives
- Turpentine and other paint solvents
- Wood preservatives

Lawn and Garden Materials

- Cesspool cleaners (corrosives)
- Flammable liquids/Gasoline
- Flea and tick powders
- Fire starters
- Fungicides
- Herbicides
- Insecticides
- No-pest strips
- Pesticides
- Poisons
- Pool chemicals
- Propane tanks, empty or partially empty, up to 20 lbs*

- Hair dye
- Nail polish remover

- Empty aerosol cans
- Fire extinguishers
- Gas cylinders (other than propane)*
- Infectious or biological wastes - medical waste can be dropped off on scheduled collection days
- Latex Paint - dried out latex paint can be disposed of with your regular trash curbside
- Medicines or syringes - medical waste can be dropped off on scheduled collection days
- PCB's
- Radioactive materials
- Smoke Detectors
- Tires

***Additional Cost**

To Ensure Safety

- NEVER MIX CHEMICALS
- NEVER SMOKE while handling hazardous materials
- Do not place waste in plastic garbage bags
- Tighten caps and lids leaving material in original labeled containers
- Sort and pack paint, pesticides and household cleaners separately
- Pack containers in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspaper
- Pack your vehicle and go directly
