Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Saugus, qualified to vote in Town affairs for the Special Town Meeting at the Saugus Town Hall located at 298 Central Street on **May 2, 2022 at 7:30 PM** to hear and act on the following articles: viz;

Article 1. To hear and act on reports of Committees.

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to create a Stabilization Fund for the Northeast Metropolitan Regional Vocational School Construction Project under M.G. L. Ch 40 s 5B as amended. (Town Manager)

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds a sum of money to be transferred to the Stabilization Fund for the Northeast Metropolitan Regional Vocational School Construction Project. (Town Manager)

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum of money for purchasing various equipment for town departments, including the payment costs incidental or related thereto; and to determine whether this appropriation shall be raised by taxation, transfer from available funds, borrowing or otherwise; or to take any other action relative thereto. (Town Manager)

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for the purchase of an aerial platform ladder truck for the Fire Department; to determine whether this appropriation shall be raised by taxation, transfer from available funds, borrowing or otherwise; or to take any other action relative thereto. (Town Manager)

Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for the purchase of a pumper truck for the Fire Department; to determine whether this appropriation shall be raised by taxation, transfer from available funds, borrowing or otherwise; or to take any other action relative thereto. (Town Manager)

Article 7. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum of money for public safety radio infrastructure upgrades, including the payment of costs incidental or related thereto; to determine whether this appropriation shall be raised by taxation, transfer from available funds, borrowing or otherwise; or to take any other action relative thereto. (Town Manager)

Article 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds a sum of money for the purpose of funding a grant match for the Green Communities Grant. (Town Manager)

Article 9. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum of money for the purpose of improving, remodeling and/or repairing Town owned buildings and facilities and purchasing equipment, including the payment of costs incidental or related thereto; to determine whether this appropriation shall be raised by taxation, transfer from available funds, borrowing or otherwise; or to take any other action relative thereto. (Town Manager)

Article 10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for the repair/replacement of the overhead doors at the Hamilton Street Fire Station. (Town Manager)

Article 11. To see if the town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to acquire title to the land and buildings located at 481-483 Lincoln Avenue Saugus, MA (Parcel Id Map E5 Block

17 Lot 3) for public parking and other municipal purposes under the provisions of MGL Chapter 40 section 14. (Town Manager)

Article 12. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum of money for the purpose of acquiring one parcel of land, building(s), demolition, improvements thereon located at 481-483 Lincoln Avenue, Saugus, MA (Parcel Id Map E5 Block 17 Lot 3) including the payment of costs incidental or related thereto; to determine whether this appropriation shall be raised by taxation, transfer from available funds, borrowing or otherwise; or to take any other action relative thereto. (Town Manager)

Article 13. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds a sum of money to be transferred to the OPEB Trust (Other Post-Employment Benefits Trust). (Town Manager)
