Article 5 is requesting the appropriation of funds for the purchase of vehicles for various departments.

Many of the vehicles purchased on behalf of the Town of Saugus in the past were salvage vehicles and at the time of purchase should not have been put on the road. Those vehicles are now substantially older - on average 13 – 15 years, no longer pass inspection, as well as continued increases to the maintenance cost – on average \$2,000 to \$3,000 per vehicle annually. In some cases, major repairs have been required to be made in order for the vehicle to pass inspection. This has created a safety issue with the use of these vehicles.

All of the vehicles listed here are used on a daily, high-demand, high-performance basis, should be fully functional, and safe.

The funding source for this appropriation is a borrowing authorization.
