Article 5 Replacement of HVAC

This appropriation of \$334,000.00 will fund a capital project to replace the HVAC units and controls at the Public Safety Building and Town Hall. The HVAC units and controls are approximately 20-25 years old and were installed when the buildings were built or renovated in the early 1990's. In recent months during operation of the HVAC systems, we have had service calls on a regular basis. The inefficiency of each unit and the controls prevent regulation of the temperature on a location basis and only on each floor of each building. The new units and controls that are internet-based, will provide energy efficiency and the ability to monitor the temperatures of the buildings during regular business hours of operation as well as when they are unoccupied.
